FAQs

Do I need to sign-up to attend Lafayette Community Day?

Yes! Please go to LafayetteCommunityDay.org to sign up and select your volunteer project.

Do I need to sign a waiver?

Yes! The City requires a waiver for participation. Please go to the link at LafayetteCommunityDay.org and complete the waiver before signing up so that when you do sign up you can check YES, this is complete.

How old do volunteers need to be?

All ages are welcome to participate in the celebrations in the park. For the Youth Homes Planting project, parent-child teams are welcome, age 6 and above. Volunteers for all other work projects need to be at least 12 years of age. Individuals under the age of 16 need to be accompanied by an adult.

Where do I park?

The best place to park is on Golden Gate Way or in one of the city parking lots off Golden Gate Way (from Plaza Park to the lot located east of 1st St.). Free ‘holiday’ parking from 9 am - 4 pm!

What should I wear?

Long sleeves, long pants, gloves, and closed-toed shoes are recommended for most projects.

What should I plan to bring with me?

Bring a water bottle, hat, and sunscreen. For Creekside Restoration, bring yard tools like clippers, shovels, rakes if you can, and a dust mask in the event you feel that you need one while clearing. Be sure to mark your tools.

Is lunch free to those who sign-up to volunteer?

Yes! Lunch is free for all those who signed up to volunteer. (Bring your own water bottle.) Others who attend for the concert and non-profit fair can purchase a lunch.

Can others attend who did not sign up?

Yes! You can attend the post-volunteer part of the day that starts at 12:30 in Plaza Park.

Are there any bathroom facilities available?

Yes! porta-potties will be on site at Plaza Park.
